DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Mendenhall House is built in the Greek Revival style with eyebrow windows in the uppermost story. It is two-and-a-half stories in height, three-bays long by two deep. A rear wing is two stories and is two-bays by two. This house is a frame building once with clapboard siding but now has asbestos shingles covering it. The sash is six-over-six with the eyebrow windows being three-over-three. There is an inside end chimney in the rear wing. The house has a gable roof with sheet metal roofing.
