The nellie's Corner Road Frame House is an excellantly kept home built sometime in the early 1800's. It is a frame structure with clapboard siding three bays by one deep. The house has a wood shingle gable roof with an inside end chimney in the south gable end. It is two stories in height with sash six panes over six. The facade has a one bay entrance porch and the rear of the building also has a porch. There is a central bay entrance, The house has a stone foundation and cellar.
