DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Job Farm site sits on a small knoll above a branch of the northEast Creek. The Job Family were early settlers in this region, they built a stone farm house here in the mid-18th century. All that remains is a clear spot between several trees.

Below the site along the stream is a small stone springhouse with a very steep roof. On the lower level is a door and spring, upper has a small shed addition with board and batten siding. The window frames are of mortice and tenor construction. One window has board and batten shutters with delicate strap hinges. The present gable roof has been covered with a sheet metal
