The Everett England House is a two story frame duplex which is three bays long by two deep. The house has a two story rear wing which is two bays long by one deep. The front section of the house has a tile like shingle exterior except for the first story of the facade which has been stuccoed. The gable roof has a brick chimney in each gable end with the eastern one being multi flue. Across the facade is a one story front porch. The house has a stone foundation and cellar. The window sash is 6/6
