DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Cottey Chandlee House is a two story log house covered with aluminum siding. The front section is three bays long by two bays deep. Originally, there were two inside end chimneys, but only one is useable today. This house has a gable roof and all the sash is new. The house has a stone foundation with cellar. A two story addition has been built on the rear of the building that replaced an earlier addition. The roof had wood shingles. The interior was not open.

Behind the house was an early barn of mortice and tenon construction. It had a slate roof and was covered with clapboard. This structure was torn down after suffering storm damage in 1975.

The Cottey Chandlee House was the home of Cottey Chandlee son of the famous clockmaker, Benjamin Chandlee. When the father left for Wilmington, his sons moved into the village. Cottey chose farming instead of clockmaking and presumably built this house.
