The Hawke House or Old Friends School is a long rectangular frame building that was moved from nearby meeting house property to its present location to serve as a private residence. The house is four bays long by roughly three bays deep. The original building was 4 by 2. The exterior surface is covered by stone bond siding shingles which cover earlier wooden siding. The building is one and a half storeys in height and has a gable roof with asphalt shingles. A cat-slide extension has been added to the southern part of the roof to cover the addition. The house has a stone foundation. On the east gable wall is an exterior brick end chimney, there is also an interior brick chimney. The east gable has an entrance with hood. The southern side of the roof The window sash was 6/6 and one set of paneled shutters still are on the structure.
