DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Trinity Church is a small one story frame structure on the east side of the Trinity Church Road. The church was built in 1898 and faces west. It is one bay long by three bays deep with the entrance in the west gable end. The original wooden siding is covered by modern aluminum siding and the roof has new asphalt shingles. The roof is very steep and the exposed rafter ends are rounded. In the center of the facade is a semi-circular window with many stained glass panes. the building has a brick stove chimney on the south wall and a stone foundation both of which have been stuccoed.

On the rear of the church a small frame fellowship hall has been added. Another addition is the small vestibule which has been built onto the facade.
