**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Wyker Victorian House is a two and one half storey brick structure built during the late 19th century or early 20th century. It has been altered somewhat in that the exterior of the house has been stuccoed and the shutters have been removed, and perhaps the window sash has been replaced. The house has an irregular shape, but is basically three bays by two with a small one bay square section built on the south side of the house. To the east side of this part of the house is the entrance which has a two light transom and a paneled Victorian era door. The gable end of this protustion has a one storey bay window with inset panels below the windows. The house has a gable roof covered with wood shingles. High in each gable is ome saw toothed ginger bread. The house has a stone foundation and a cellar. On the west gable is an exterior and chimney built of brick.

To the rear of the house is a small one storey frame building with board and batten siding, it also has a gab le roof with wood shingles.
