**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Cherry Grove School was built in 1881, by Jackson Brothers for \$680.00. It is 24' by 32'. It is a frame building, a single story in height with an enclosed porch on the south gable end- one bay in size with a central door flanked by small windows. The sash is 6/6 throughout. The foundation is constructed of brick and stone from an earlier structure (school) built in 1847. A small central brick stove chimney provided heat. The roof is a gable with modern asbestos shingles.
