**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Lombard Greek Revival House is a brick house two stories in height, three bays across by two bays deep. The bricks have been covered with stucco. Beneath the overhang of the gable roof is an ornamental brick cornice that resembles colonial dentil blocks or dentils. The facade has a side bay entrance with sidelights and a transom. The facade of the house has a one story porch with turned posts. The roof has double inside end chimneys in each gable wall.

The house has a stone foundation and a cellar. The original window sash has been removed and the current sash is 2/2. There are no shutters on this building.
