Joel Lynn Farmhouse is a two story frame structure three bays by two with a rear wing. The exterior covering of the frame work is novelty siding. This building has a gable roof with a central peaked dormer. On the east side of this dormer is a brick chimney. The rear wing is two stories in height with an inside ind chimney in the south gable wall. All of the windows have been replaced with modern single pane sash. Across the front of the house is a one story porch supported by wooden pillars.
