4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC YES

This is a very small A-roofed structure with the entrance on the gable end. It is three bays wide and four deep and has a central door. The door is an old one and has the original beautifully made brass lock inscribed with the makers name. All of the windows in the Church are 9/6 sashes and contain old glass. There is an oculus window in the pediment. A small porch covers the front door of the Church and there is a small cupola on the roof. The interior of the Church is one large space with a plaster barrel-vaulted ceiling. The pulpit is in a corner. There is a central section of six pews flanked by a narrow row on either side. The panelling in the Church is lovely and has been well-restored. It is painted a deep soft grey with white walls. This small Church, originally a chapel of ease on the Bohemia Manor to the Sassafras Church, has been restored very well. For its size it is an extremely well-panelled Church and is architecturally note-worthy.

Marker inscription:
 First called "Mannoar Chappel" a chapel of ease of North Sassafras Parish. Established in Bohemia manor in compliance with an act of the Maryland Assembly 1692
 Excellent condition Erected as a separate parish 1744.
