DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Kites Mill is a two story frame mill that has been converted into a duplex apartment building. It was originally located further upstream and moved to its present site around 1900. The structure is four bays long by two bays deep with a high stone foundation. The framework is covered with novelty siding. There are two entrances on the facade of the mill. The roof has: metal corrugated sheets which have replaced an earlier shingle roof. The window sash are 6/6 throughout. There is an interior cinder block chimney which was probably built within the last ten years.
