DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Harvey Greek Revival House is a large frame structure three stories in height five bays long by two deep with a rear wing two stories in height three bays long. The house is shaped like an upside down T with the facade facing the southeast and the Little Elk Creek. The house has a gable roof with a central peaked dormer and a smaller gable dormer on each side of the center. Two brick stove chimneys protrude from the roof, one on each side of the center dormer. The exterior of the building is covered with shingle siding. Along the edge of the roof is pierced gingerbread. The central dormer of the roof has a finial and pendant. The third story has eyebrow windows of 3/3 sash. The rest of the windows have 5/6 sash. The facade of the house has a three bay single story entrance porch. This porch has elaborate woodent carvings for ornamental purposes. The house has a central entrance with transom.
