DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Providence Corner House is a stone structure and a half stories in height, two bays by two bays. The house has a stucco covering and gable roof. In the western gable is an inside end chimney built of brick. This building is constructed against the side of a hill with entrances on the first and second floors. A small frame addition has been built on the northern side of the building. It appears to have served as a stable. All of the window and door frames are pegged. All of the windows are without sash or are boarded over.
