**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Muller House is a stone dwelling which is two stories in height and is approximately two bays long by one deep. The house has a gable roof covered with corrugated metal. The original roof was probably wood shingle. There is a brick end chimney in each gable wall. The exterior surface has been covered with stucco and whitewash. Although the original sash has been removed the house probably had 6/6 sash. The facade of the house has a one story frame addition built onto it. The house is a double house with an entrance and exit for each side. There is a small frame addition on the rear of the house. The interior was not visible or available for inspection.
