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**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Dupont Farm consists of three major buildings; Two dwellings and a very large barn. The main house is frame and was built C. 1865. It is two stories in height and is three bays long by two deep. The gable roof has asphalt shingles with brick inside end chimneys in each gable wall. The exterior of the house has siding "tile" shingles. In the central bay of the facade is an entrance with a transom and sidelights. The house has a stone foundation with cellar.

The other dwelling is also frame and dates from roughly the same period. The wooden siding has been covered with stucco. The house is two stories in height with an inside end chimney built of brick in the west gable wall. The house is about two bays long by one deep. Across the facade is a one story front porch. This building was probably used as a tenant house.

Behind the houses is a very large frame barn with board and batten siding and a gable roof. The barn was a stone foundation and dates from circa 1900.
