| <p>4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC <u>NO</u></p> <p>This is a very long five bay two and a half storey high house with a rather gently pitched "A"-roof. Originally the house may have been three bays long and the left two bays may have been added later. There are two doors on the front of the house and all the windows ^{have} are 6/6 sashes. There are three 6/6 peaked dormers on the roof. There are two huge brick chimneys enclosed within the walls of the house. The house is rather narrow for its length and appears to be one room deep. To the right of the main house is a samml two bay wide one and a half storey addition with a very steeply pitched A-roof which forms a rather large overhang in the front of the house. This wing has a large chimney built into its right end. It has basement windows filled with wooden lintels. From its size and the pitch of its roof, it may possibly be the oldest part of this house.</p> <p>---The entire structure is of fieldstone covered with stucco. It is well-preserved and maintained and is interesting in that it shows a composite fieldstone house and how it grew.</p> | |
