DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Childs Row 1 house is a frame building two stories in height, three bays long by two deep. This dwelling has clapboard siding. The gable roof is covered with asbestos shingles and has an inside end chimney in the south gable wall. This chimney is made of bricks and is a stove chimney. Across the facade is a one story porch with turned support posts that have brackets attached to them and the roof. Between the posts is a short railing. The entrance to this dwelling is in the center bay of the facade. The house has a stone foundation. The window sash throughout are 2/2 at one time there appear to have been shutters on the house.

The house has a two story rear wing also of frame construction with siding that matches the front section. In the gable wall of this section is a brick chimney.

The front yard is enclosed with a cast iron fence.
