4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION <span style="float: right;">OPEN TO PUBLIC <u>NO</u></span>  <p>This is a rather unusual house which has undergone many additions. It, in its present state, is three bays wide and four deep. All the windows <del>have</del> six-over-six sashes. There is a central door with an overlight and sidelights. The third storey has half-size three-over-three windows and is right up under the flat roof. Above this, right under the roof is a row of recessing bricks with a row of brick dentils beneath.</p> <p>Originally, this house was only two bays wide and was constructed c. 1790. It was enlarged to its present size c. 1839. At that time the cast iron porch was affixed to the front of the house. This is a very elaborate <del>it</del> porch with cast-iron pillars twined with grape vines and a frieze of maidens above. There <del>is</del> an old meat room on the third floor of the house. In its present state the house presents a unified appearance in the late Federal - Early Greek Revival style. It is a very attractive well-maintained structure <del>unusual in style for Cecil County.</del> <i>The iron-work is very similar to houses in Elkton</i></p> <p>There are two old cannon of unknown origin stuck in the ground out in the garden. There are also many large old holly trees on the property.</p>


