The north wing is an early gambrel roof building which has a large central chimney. There are two bays on each side of the chimney. The unusual feature of this house is that the rear upper pitch of the roof is alongated, producing an asymetrical gambrel roof. The entire dwelling is covered in barn red asbestos siding.
