This dwelling is a two story frame structure which was covered with clapboard but now has aluminum siding. The main section of the house is three bays long by two. There is a chimney in the east gable end and the roof has asphalt shingles. The facade has a front porch with Victorian brackets.

A rear kitchen wing is located to the south of the main section. It is also two stories in height. On the rear wall of this addition is a large chimney (brick) . Another small addition has been added to this wing, a leanto extension one story in height.
