**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Demond House is a three-story frame building with clapboard siding. It has a gable roof with central dormer. The roof has a low pitch. The house is three bays wide by four deep. On the north wall there is an inside end chimney. There is a one story porch on the facade added in the 20th century. The front door is of Victorian style as is the screen door. The window sash is 6/6 on the first two floors and 3/6 on the third. Originally the house was three bays long by two bays deep. To the rear is a small frame addition. The house has a stone foundation.
