DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Farmers Hotel is located on the outskirts of the Village of Calvert. It is a large frame structure built in 1858 by John Pierson. It is two and a half stories in height with an inside end chimney in the west and east gable walls. The building is five bays across by two bays deep. Across the facade is a one story porch built in the early twentieth century. In the central bay of the facade are two doors with transoms. The window sash of the first story is 9/6 and 6/6 on the second floor. On the south side of the gable roof is a three window shed dormer which also appears to be an alteration. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The exterior of the hotel is covered with aluminum siding. The replaced clapboard siding. The hotel has a stone foundation. A small shed addition has been built on the east gable end and a door cut into this wall at the second story level to accommodate a fire escape.

A brick building has been constructed on the property, one story in height and serves as a nursing home as does the hotel. It is a 20th century building.
