### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Martindale House is a large frame dwelling built in the period of Italianate influence perhaps 1840-50. The house is shaped like an L. The front section is three bays long by two deep and two stories in height, The gable roof is covered with a metal roof. The roof has a box cornice which is supported by brackets. The facade has a side bay entrance with transom. Across the front of the house is a one story front porch with a relatively flat roof supported by cast iron supports in a grape arbor design. If there was a chimney and I assume that there was it has been taken down. The rear section of this structure is also two stories in height, and of frame construction. The west wall of this section has a two story porch which is fairly common to the area. The house has a stone foundation. The exterior walls are covered with white shingles. The window sash is 2/2 on the first story and 6/6 on the second. New shutters have been put on the house.
