DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Bauer Black Farmhouse is a Victorian frame dwelling two and a half stories in height. It is three bays long by two deep with a two story two bay by one rear wing. This house has level siding and rests on a stone foundation and cellar whose exterior walls have been stuccoed. The facade has a front porch which has turned posts, with pierced brackets and finials. The porch is one story in height and also has a hand rail with turned balusters. The front of the house has a central entrance with double doors which are flanked by sidelights and have a transom overhead. The gable roof has patterned slate shingles and two interior brick chimney in its center. Also in the central part of the roof is a peaked dormer containing a lancet window. The window sash is 2/2 throughout and the windows have lowered shutters.

The rear wing is of similiar construction but has an inside end chimney in the south gable and a single story porch on the east and west walls of the house.

There are several frame outbuildings. The earliest two appear to be the carriage shed and the barn. There is a small two story house near the main building which might have been a workshop. There also is a priuy near the carriage shed.
