DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Zion Methodist Church is a large frame structure built in the High Victorian Gothic Style around 1870. It is a story and a half in height and two bays long by bays deep. The exterior is covered with weatherboarding. To the east side of the church protruding from the sloping gable roof is a bell tower. The bell tower is composed of an open wooden framework with a pedimented roof shaped like a cross with a gable facing in each direction. The roof has wooden shingles with small pointed finials at the top of each gable. The rafter ends are lightly carved to match those of the main church roof.

The facade of the church has a small vestibule whose roof matches the main structures roof. It has a cross timber from one side of the gable to the other which is bisected by another timber which is incorporated in the peak of the roof. There is a pendant on the bottom of this member and a finial on top of the roof. The front doors have a pointed top and the vestibule is flanked by a lancet window with stained glass. In the west wall of the church is a brick stove chimney. The church has a stone foundation and a small cellar.

Behind the church is a small graveyard.
