4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a very high and deep house with a steeply pitched A-roof. It is four bays wide and slightly deeper than its width. The first story windows are 9/6 sashes while those on the second story are 6/6. All of the windows have old bubbly glass. There are three windows at the attic level on the gable ends. There is a huge stone chimney enclosed in each end of the house. Along the front and rear roof line is a cornice made of layers of cut projecting fieldstone. There is a porch along the front of the house. A stone barn which appears quite old is at the rear of the property. There is also a stone well house. Both of these out-buildings, like the main house, are in an excellent state of preservation. This house presents an interesting and attractive profile with its large and generous proportions. It is historically important for its age and because of its usage as a stagecoach inn on the Annapolis-Philadelphia Route.
