

The Zebley Farmhouse is a mid-19th century brick house, with flush chimneys at either gable end. The two story, three bay main block is one room deep with an attached contemporary kitchen wing. Three bays wide, the first floor of the front façade consists of a central entrance flanked by 6/6 sash windows with paneled shutters, sheltered by a shed-roofed porch supported by ornate square posts and sawn brackets. The second floor holds three 6/6 sash windows with paneled shutters. A corbeled dentiled cornice decorates the roofline. The brick walls are constructed with an unusual bond pattern, with alternating common and Flemish bond courses.





Tax Map 14


