DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Oldfield Point Log and Frame house is an early to mid-18th century dwelling built in the colonial style. The house is two-storeys in height and is four bays long by two deep. The house has a gable (steep) roof of wood shingles with a plain box cornice across the facade is a one-storey front porch of recent construction. The exterior of the structure is covered with umbricated siding shingles. The house has a brick foundation and an interior brick chimney. The north end of the house appears to be log and the oldest central entrance with a raised panel (six) door. The southern half of the house is frame and is an addition.

Numerous foundation walls show the location of outbuildings which have been gone from the form for a number of years.

An interior investigation would be very helpful and important.
