DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Hostteter House is located at the end of a long driveway on the side of a hill. In older days the house had a view of the Susquehannah. It is a large frame building two-storeys in height, three bays long by two deep with a small storey and a half wing on the east gable end. The house has a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles (as does the kitchen wing). The roof has a plain box cornice. The exterior of the building is protected by wood shingles nailed in stone bond style. The house has an exterior stone chimney on the west gable wall. The house has a stone foundation and cellar. Across the facade is a one storey front porch. The window sash is 9/9 on the first floor and 6/6 on the second. The kitchen wing has a brick inside end chimney in its east gable wall.

There is a small carriage shed and some other small outbuildings all in poor condition.

The interior of the house was not open to view.
