This is a very small rough fieldstone house which may have originally been a miller's house. It is located on a wide stream right near Gilpin's Covered Bridge and there are ruins of a dam and possibly of a mill-race nearby. The house is two bays wide and one deep with a rather steeply pitched A-roof. All the windows are 6/0 sashes, and the door occupies the left front bay. There is a fieldstone chimney built into the right end wall of the house. There is a frame ell at the rear of the house. This structure is well-preserved and may have some historical significance with a mill site nearby.
