

C.1774 uncoursed stone foundation supports 20th century 2 1/2 - story residential structure that has undergone numerous modifications and additions. It has a side-gable entrance and a 2nd-story wrap-around balcony, wood and stone porch supports. The structure lacks any distinct characteristics of a type, period or method of construction that would meet National Register criteria for design and construction.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The purpose of this survey is only to record the existance of a earlier set of building at this location. The only visible remains of a early building is the uncoursed stone gable end wall to this primarily 20th century structure. The wall, according to the owners was the end wall of slave quarters. The wall measures approximately 13'6" in length. It is 2 stories high with a brick cap to the stone chimney pile. The present structure is ~~associated with~~ 2 bays across by one room deep and a small part of a rather large house. The earlier buildings were supposedly lost in an extensive fire and the stone wall is all that remains.




