This structure is reputed to have been an old general store and was supposedly built for that purpose. It is 1-1/2 stories high with a steeply sloping A-roof. It is 3 bays wide and 2 deep. All of the windows are 12/8 sashes, and have old bubbly glass. The central door is an old panelled one. There is an enclosed brick chimney at each end of the house. The logs are grooved and laid on one another German style. The structure has a twentieth century porch around it and a new dormer on the roof. There are signs where an older porch was once joined to the house. The logs on the front of the structure are chinked and covered with whitewash. One side and the rear of the structure are now covered with clapboard.

This building is in good condition, but at present appears to be deserted.


