Old Elk Neck Methodist Church is fairly significant since it is one of the earliest church buildings surviving on the Elk Neck Peninsula. Vertical plank construction has been attested to by a local craftsman which makes it a particularly important structure. ~~Some~~ early tombstones are found in the adjacent graveyard and date to the early 19th Century.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Neck Road Methodist Church c. 1830-1850 is located just north of the intersection with Irishtown Road. The southeast gable end serves as the main facade with the main axis corresponding to an southeast/northwest orientation.

The 1½ story rectangular structure measures 25' 5" by 30' 5" and rests on an uncoursed fieldstone footing. A local carpenter described a vertical plank framing system under the ~~side~~ exterior weatherboards. The structure is covered with a medium sloped composition tile gable roof. The eaves are extended and short returns are found at the base.

The main facade has a central entrance with a 2 light transom and a slight bead on the surround. A window opening with shutters closed lights the probable balcony.

The north and south sides have two 12/12 sash windows with two panel shutters. A recent block stove stack rises on the northeast side.

The interior was not seen at the time of inspection.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Old Elk Neck Methodist Church is fairly significant since it is one of the earliest church buildings surviving in the Elk Neck area. The others have either moved or another structure has been built. The vertical plank construction, according to the carpenter's description, is extremely significant since it is one of a handful of known buildings with this framing method.

Some fairly early tombstones are found in the adjacent graveyard with some dating back to the early 1800's.


