Guilbault House

A 16 acre tract known as "Millford" with a two story log house is located just south of the Pennsylvania line along Red Hill Road (DS 4/425). The tract was transferred to John L. McGuigan from Jeremiah and Ruthanna McGuigan in April of 1871.

The McGuigan name naturally appears on the Lake, Griffing, and Stevenson Atlas.

 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Guilbault House c. 1850 is located on Red Hill Road just south of the Pennsylvania,-Maryland Line. The house has a north/south compass orientation with the main facade facing east.

The Guilbault house has been remodeled and added on to through the years but a central core (24'x16') is log. The house has had several shed roof additions plus a half gable on the south side. The log structure unlike the rest of the house rests on an uncoursed stone foundation. The entire exterior of the house has been covered with an asbestos siding. The roof is of medium pitch and sheathed with a composition tile. A later brick chimney is found on the north end. The original log structure was 2 bays long by one room deep. The structure was two stories in height. The original windows have all been removed and changed around. The walls are 10" to 12" thick which does prove the logs exist.

The Guilbault House appears on both the Martenet Map (1858) under Jno. McGuigan and the Lake Atlas (1877) under J. McGuigan. The house is log but has been extensively remodeled and therefore has lost most of its architectural significance. It is one of a few remaining log buildings in the area.


