

CE-875, CE-876, CE-877

Mt. Zoar Community

C. 1860-1890

Mount Zoar is a black settlement that began in the 3rd quarter of the 19th Century along Mt. Zoar Road and just west of Route 222. Approximately one dozen structures stand both along the road and back from it in no discernable relation to one another. Located among the standard two story 2 bay by 1 room frame houses is a frame Methodist church (CE-877) and a 19th Century frame schoolhouse with projecting entrance and bell tower. (CE-876). The schoolhouse is one of the more unusual of its type in the entire county.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The A.M.E. Methodist Church c. 1870 is the church located nearest the Mt. Zear Black Community, and has probably been used as their church building ever since it was built. The church is also located on Mount Zear Road a 1/2 mile from Route 222. The church is 3 bays across by 3 bays deep. It is, however, much deeper than it is wide. The building rests on an uncoursed stone foundation but has been sheathed with aluminum siding. The front entrance is a projecting pavilion from the main block and has a small bell tower.

The sanctuary windows are 6/6 sash with plain trim. The boxed cornice is also covered with aluminum and the medium sloped roof is covered with asphalt shingles.
