 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Little remains of this barn north of Route 1 and just a $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of the Susquehanna River. A long dirt road leads to it from Route 1. The barn is found on about the highest ground in the nearby vicinity and probably once overlooked the Susquehanna. The ruin presently remains in the midst of a relatively new growth of trees.

One corner of uncoursed stone with large stone quoins remains and stands about 25 feet high. The structure was about 28' across by 20' deep. A wooden lintel is also intact on a south wall. The 1877 Lake Atlas has the name E.E. Hall associated with the area.


