Sealark Farm house was previously called Herndon. It is two story brick Italianate villa. Atop the nearly flat roof is a pent house type captain's watch. the "L" shaped house is five bays wide and five bays deep and faces northeast. On each side of the center bay is a projected brick pilaster extending to a pediment in which is a semi-circular window with radiating muntins. The main double door has side lights and transom. The wooden front porch extends the full length of the facade and has a heavy bracketed cornice and shaped splat railing. The 4 over 4 windows have panelled shutters on the first floor and louvered shutters above. The door on the southeast has a porch similar to the front porch. There is a basement entrance under this side porch. The entrance porch on the northwest is framed by a large brick arch. There is question as to whether the house encloses an earlier structure. All chimneys have tile pots. It is in good condition.
