This is an attractive, well-proportioned house of the Federal period. It is three bays wide and four deep. It has a central door and all the windows have new six over six sashes. The A-roof is gently sloped. There is an enclosed chimney ⁱⁿ ~~at~~ each ~~side~~ ^{gable} of the house. There is also a door on the left ~~side~~ ^{gable} of the main house. This is a simple house of the early nineteenth century, but its well-maintained appearance and proportions make it worthy of note.
