DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Windy Hill, a two story three by one room plan, is located along the Rock Springs - New Bridge Road. The house faces the road and north, with the main gable running east/west. This house is one of dozens that are found in the area and remain as reminders of the late 19th century development in this vicinity. The house has not retained much exterior detail and the interior was not open for inspection. The house is on the 1877 map under the name Riley.

The frame structure has a shed porch on the main frame and gable additions to the rear (south). The entire exterior is covered with aluminum, and the medium pitched roof with composition tiles. ~~The window sash has been replaced.~~


