Various owners have removed most of this structure's original exterior detail, however, the basic two story three bay by one room log house remains under the weatherboard sheathing and additions. The log house which stands along side Ragan Road was owned in 1858 by Mrs. H. Hathaway (Martenet) and a Mrs. Rudolph in 1877. (Lake, Griffing and Stevenson.)

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Hathaway-Randolph House c. 1830-1860 is a 2 1/2 story log structure 3 bays across by one room deep with a 2 story ell addition to the rear. The house faces south with the main gable running east/west. The Old Conowingo Road runs directly in front of the house.

The main log block rests on an uncoursed stone foundation. The exterior weatherboards have been covered with aluminum siding and the medium pitched roof sheathed with a composition tile. Due to the aluminum siding the corner notching was not visible. The owner had seen the logs, however, when remodeling took place.

The main (south) facade is three bays across with the central bay as an entrance. The window sash have been replaced with 1/1 sash and plain trim. A front porch was added in the late 19th or early 20th century and extends around to the east side.

The east gable end is partially covered with the single story porch. There is one window on the second floor and a 4 pane attic light. A stretcher bond chimney stack rises out of the gable end and topped with a two course cap.

The rear addition has also been aluminum sided and remodeled.

The interior has also been extensively remodeled in the recent past.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house remains as an early example of the prominent one room plan with rear additions that commonly appears ~~later~~ in the ^{19th} century in the Conowingo area. The house does retain its basic exterior 19th century form. The property ~~does~~ appears on the 1858 Martenet Map under the ownership of Mr. H. Hathaway. By 1877 it had changed owners and a Mrs. Rudolph had possession of the property.


