This building is a very plain narrow structure with a gently sloping A-roof. It is five bays long and one room deep. There are two chimneys within the walls of the house. Originally the house was three bays long and two more bays were added. This addition is clearly seen in the exterior construction of the house.

~~It is rumored that this dwelling (at least the original three bays) is constructed of squared logs with the tarpaper shingles laid on top of them. If so, the structure is important for this reason. It has no other merit.~~
