4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a rather attractive and unusual example of the wooden Victorian House in the Gothic mode. It is 3 bays wide and 2 deep with a 2 story ell at the rear. The roof is rather steeply pitched and has a tall steeply pitched gable in the center of the front roof. This gable and the two gabled ends of the house are decorated with cut and pierced bargeboards. There is an interior chimney at each end of the house. The unusual feature of this house is that all the windows are round-arched ones, lending an almost Romanesque air to the house. There is a one story porch across the front of the house decorated with cut wooden decoration. The central door has an overlight and sidelights.

The round-arched windows and the proportions of this house make it an interesting and note-worthy one. At present it is rapidly deteriorating.
