School No. 7 was undoubtedly built along Crystal Beach Road because of its central location between Earleville and the wharf at the west end of Crystal Beach Road. This road was undoubtedly well traveled and the numerous mid to late 19th century houses attest to the activity. The school has been converted to a residence like most school buildings but this one does retain some original 9/9 sash that are usually replaced when the window opening is made smaller.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

School No. 7 is a 1½ story frame school building on Crystal Beach Road west of Earleville, Md. The structure faces north with the primary axis running north/south.

The structure rests on a fieldstone foundation and is sheathed with narrow weatherboard. The medium sloped composition tile roof has extended eaves and sloped soffit. A brick stove stack rises out of the center of the structure.

The north facade is three bays across with a central entrance and flanking 6/6 sash that have replaced the earlier 9/9 sash that one finds across the west side. A hip roofed porch covers the three bays on the northern end and is supported by champhered posts. A nine pane light illuminates the attic.

The east side has smaller single pane sash with a central entry with single bay gabled porch. A single story shed addition is attached to the south end with a window in each end.

The interior was not seen but not particularly necessary since it has been remodeled for a residence.

School No. 7 is another example of the typical school building built in the mid 19th century. This one has been extensively altered to suit a living space on the west side. The structure does not offer anything in the way of unusual construction but does have its place in the educational history of the first district.
