DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lynch-Rath House c. 1870 is a 2 story side hall/ parlor plan frame house on Biddle Road (?) and west of Warwick Md. The house faces east with the main gable running north/south.

The main block has a two story ell wing 2 bays across by one room deep. The house rests on a stuccoed fieldstone foundation and is totally covered with aluminum siding over the original weatherboard. The steeply pitched roof is covered with composition tile.

The east (main) facade is 3 bays across with the entrance in the southern bay opening. The 4 panel door has a plain surrounds and so do the 2/2 window sash. A shed roof porch with square posts covers the first floor. A boxes cornice stretches across at the base of the roof.

Two 3/3 lights illuminate the attic space. The stove stack has been removed from above the roofline. The eaves are extended with short returns at the base. The south end has a hall 2/2 light and second floor sash.

The kitchen ell section is basically plain with a closed-in shed addition on the south side.

The detailing is the same as the main block. An exterior block stove stack rises against the north wall.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

L. W. Lynch was owning this modest late 19th century structure in 1877 according to the Lake, Griffing and Stevenson Atlas. The house is a common form that has been widely used since the 18th century. The exterior has been stripped of any late 19th century details it may have had. The interior has retained some of its original woodwork. The house, however was primarily done for inventory purposes only.
