William Wilson, a Delawarean farmer of Appoquinimink Hundred owned six tenant houses on southeastern Cecil County to operate his extensive grain and peach farm. The three story five bay by one room mansard roof structure has a central hall. A single story two bay by one room kitchen wing is attached to east (back side) elevation of the main block.



