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8. Statement of Significance
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The Pomfret Road House has been demolished. No physical evidence of its location remains.

In a circa 1970 survey, the house was described as a "good example of the 'field hand' or 'slave' cabin once dotting the Southern Maryland countryside." The house was described as being two stories in height and three bays wide with a centered entrance and two second story windows. A single-flue exterior brick chimney stood at the east gable end of the dwelling, and the interior first floor was divided into two rooms. A stair led to the second floor which held a small landing and one bedroom.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

THIS PARTICULAR BUILDING IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF THE "FIELD HAND" OR "SLAVE" CABIN ONCE DOTTING THE SO. MD. COUNTRYSIDE BUT NOW FEW IN NUMBER, THIS BUILDING HOWEVER, IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF THAT TYPE OF BUILDING AS IT HAS REMAINED RELATIVE UNTOUCHED THROUGH THE YEARS AND IS VISIBLY IN GOOD STRUCTURAL CONDITION.

STANDING ON THE N. SIDE OF MD. RTE. 227 FROM 301 TO POWFRET JUST BEYOND THE MIDDLETOWN - MT. 227 INTERSECTION THIS "CABIN" IS EASILY VISABLE AND ACCESSABLE FROM THE MAIN ROAD. THE HOUSE IS 3 BAYS WITH CENTER DOOR IN LENGTH WITH 2 WINDOWS ON THE SECOND FLOOR LEVEL. THE ROOF DESIGN IS "A" PLAN WITH A SINGLE AVE CHIMNEY ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE EAST GABLE. AT THE REAR OF THE HOUSE ARE A CENTER DOOR AND FLANKING WINDOW TO THE WEST SIDE AND SMALL WINDOW DIRECTLY ABOVE THE DOOR. AT THE E GABLE THERE IS A SMALL ONE STOREY ADDITION OF VICTORIAN VINTAGE WITH A LEAN-TO ROOF.

ON THE INTERIOR THE HOUSE HAS ONE ROOM AT THE EAST END WITH FIREPLACE AND SMALL NARROW WEST ROOM WITH A SMALL STAIRCASE AT THE SW CORNER. THE SECOND FLOOR LEVEL HAS A SMALL LANDING AND BEDROOM.

THE TOP OF THE 2ND FLOOR WINDOW MLDGS. IS ALMOST FLUSH WITH THE EAVE CORNICE. THE CORNICE MLDG. IS PLAIN AND BOXED.


