



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located in a close proximity to the dwelling house of Millbrook Farm is the mill for which the farm was undoubtedly named. As one of the last remaining (if not the last) mills of Charles County it deserves special attention.

Of frame construction two storeys in height the mill retains much of its originality. The roof is the all typical Aⁿ frame with the ridge running east to west the main entrance is at the ground level, west end while the wheel and shaft are to the east end. On the exterior the overall composition is of a ramshackle barn since much of the siding has been replaced along with the roof and wheel. All the interior wooden works are in place including the round cases which held the stones — the stones are scattered about the farm and can be salvaged.

Much of the interior materials appear to be of chestnut and all in excellent condition. The foundation is field stone and opens to a bank cellar at the north wall.
