7: Description:

Located on the south side of Pomfret Road, the Marshall House is a one and one-half-story, three-bay, frame building with asbestos siding. The side-gable house, built between 1942 and 1943 rests on a concrete block foundation and features paired and single one-over-one sash windows, asphalt shingle roof, an interior brick chimney, and hipped dormers. The front-gable entry porch is enclosed. There is a small side ell with paired six-over-six sash windows and a small rear ell. There is a large circa 1945 barn and shed south of the house. The barn is frame with vertical wood siding, concrete block foundation, large sliding doors in the gable end, and standing seam metal roof. The shed is concrete block, has an asphalt shingle roof and is in a deteriorated condition.


#8: Statement of Significance:


